POLLING STATION

Don't forget that our school is closed to children on the day of the European referendum. The polling station will be in our Year 1 class again but we anticipate it being busier than the local elections and so have swapped our INSET day from the Friday.

ROBINWOOD

If your child is going to **Robinwood in September** you will have received a letter indicating the amount left to pay. Please try to get the balances cleared **before 15th July** so that we can make our final payment to the company who organises all the fantastic activities.

SUN SAFE

As the weather warms up, please make sure that your child has a high factor sun cream applied before they come to school in the morning.

The children are playing out at lunchtime during the hottest part of the day so need a good application of **sunscreen** in the morning that should last all day. All our youngest children wear hats when they are outside as well and it is a good idea to let your child wear a **cap** on sunny days – just make sure that it has their name inside it.

Remember the five S's of Sun Safety:

SLIP, SLOP, SLAP, SLIDE, SHADE

1. **SLIP** on a T-shirt that will keep shoulders covered as they can easily burn
2. **SLOP** on sunscreen (minimum SPF 30, with high/broad-spectrum UVA protection)
3. **SLAP** on a broad brimmed hat to shade your face neck & ears
4. **SLIDE** on sunglasses to protect your eyes
5. **SHADE** from the sun when possible, particularly between 11am -3pm
