JUSTICE AND FAITH DAY

Miss Vause has organised our Justice and Faith day for **Friday 14th July** to give our oldest children an idea of some of the organisations working for fairness in the world and ways in which individuals and groups can support them. One of the main aspects of St Edmund's being a Romero School is to help the children understand how we can help people in other countries to be treated fairly.

The Justice and Faith day will finish with Year 4/5 and Year 6 leading our **collective worship at 2.45pm.**

Everyone is invited to come into school to share this lovely event with us.

SUN SAFE

As the weather warms up, please make sure that your child has a high factor sun cream applied before they come to school in the morning.

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The children are playing out at lunchtime during the hottest part of the day so need a good application of **sunscreen** in the morning that should last all day. All our youngest children wear hats when they are outside as well and it is a good idea to let your child wear a **cap** on sunny days – just make sure that it has their name inside it.

Remember the five S's of Sun Safety: SLIP, SLOP, SLAP, SLIDE, SHADE

1. **SLIP** on a T-shirt that will keep shoulders covered as they can easily burn
2. **SLOP** on sunscreen (minimum SPF 30, with high/broad-spectrum UVA protection)
3. **SLAP** on a broad brimmed hat to shade your face neck & ears
4. **SLIDE** on sunglasses to protect your eyes
5. **SHADE** from the sun when possible, particularly between 11am -3pm

CELEBRATION MASS

On **Wednesday 12th July at 9.30am** we will be celebrating Mass in school and we invite all our parents, grandparents and friends from the Parish.
