ACTIVE SCHOOLS: SKELMERSDALE

Our Year 5 class have been taking part in a project to look at the ways in which we can increase our activity in school and at home.

When it is cold and dark outside during the winter months it might be difficult to be active with the indoors being both warmer and safer. However, when we are inside it is important that children and adults do not spend prolonged or extended periods of time sitting still as this can be bad for your health.

Some easy ways to get children moving and breaking up sitting time can include, making the advert breaks on TV active by moving about or doing quick chores whenever they come on, or having a home rule that whenever anyone sits for an hour they then have to move around the house for at least 10 minutes.
